## Earn thousands of dollars for your classroom or team! 2018-2019 topic is, Resolved: Humans are primarily driven by self-interest.

#### Minimum requirements

At least 15 students should compete in 3 rounds. Elimination rounds are not required, and rounds do not need to be held in one day. Parents and volunteers are welcome to judge. Students and judges will fill out a brief survey after the event.

## Hold the event in whatever way works best for you! Some ideas:

- Hold a scrimmage with your team members at an after-school practice.
- Invite science teachers to do debates in their classroom during the school day.
- Add Big Questions as a consolation event at your upcoming tournament.

#### Do I need to be a member to hold an event?

Due to the demand for the Big Questions Grant, only NSDA members will be eligible to receive funding. If you are currently a non-member school, you can apply part of your Big Questions grant to cover the cost of membership! NSDA membership benefits include:

- Honor Society Membership for coach and student recognition
- Access to resources including textbooks, lesson plans, and topic analyses
- Access to our district and national tournament series
- Access to National Tournament videos through 2018

### Money earned depends on the number of student competitors:

- A minimum of \$400 will be awarded for 15 participants and \$10 per additional student if 1 school is competing or \$20 per student if 2 or more schools are competing in Big Questions.
- Host several events to earn more money for your program! There is a \$7500 cap per entity.
- We have \$450,000 to award annually and \$20,000 in scholarships will be awarded at Nationals
- Grant money can be used for classroom supplies or fund speech and debate activities!

- We have a Judge training course and demonstration round video.
- A format manual and topic analysis
