

A Bill to Provide Assertive Community Treatment to Veterans in Crisis

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
- 2 **SECTION 1**. Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) programs will be provided to
- veterans suffering from mental illness related to their term of service.
- 4 **SECTION 2**. ACT includes programs such as Mental Health Intensive Case
- 5 Management and is geared toward allowing patients to live
- 6 independently while receiving services.
- 7 **SECTION 3.** The Veterans Health Administration will fund this program in the amount
- of \$200 million for fiscal year 2017. After a review of the program to
- determine its effectiveness, this may be renewed by the Secretary of
- 10 Veterans Affairs.
- 11 **SECTION 4.** This will take effect on October 1, 2016.
- SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.



A Bill to End Civil Commitment for Sex Offenders

1	BE IT ENACTE	ED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
2	SECTION 1.	States are no longer permitted to use open-ended civil commitment to
3		imprison convicted sex offenders once they have completed their
4		sentence.
5	SECTION 2.	Civil commitment refers to the practice of transferring sex offenders to
6		mental institutions for an undefined period of time after the completion
7		of their prison sentence until they "no longer pose a threat." This does
8		not refer to sex-offender registration programs.
9	SECTION 3.	The Department of Justice will oversee enforcement of this legislation.
10		A. States found in violation shall forfeit their grant monies from the
11		Office of Violence against Women (OVW) programs until they are in
12		compliance.
13	SECTION 4.	This shall take effect 6 months after passage.

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Promote Computer Coding Requirements In Schools

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
- 2 **SECTION 1**. Grants in the amount of \$250 million per year shall be provided to states
- that require computer coding as a graduation requirement.
- 4 **SECTION 2**. Traditional PC programming and mobile platform application coding are
- 5 both eligible for grant consideration.
- 6 **SECTION 3.** The Department of Education will administer the awarding and oversight
- of these grants. These grants are renewable for a period of five years.
- 8 **SECTION 4.** This will take effect on September 1, 2016.
- 9 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.



A Bill to Discourage Export Tourism

- 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
- 2 **SECTION 1**. A tariff of 25% shall be placed upon any declared goods in excess of
- \$3,000 retail value which are purchased in the United States and
- 4 exported to China or Chinese controlled territories, if such items were
- 5 purchased in the course of tourist activities.
- 6 **SECTION 2**. This shall not apply if the purchaser is a registered exporter.
- 7 **SECTION 3.** The Department of State and the Bureau of Consular Affairs will enforce
- 8 this legislation.
- A. Items found in violation of this law shall be confiscated.
- SECTION 4. Upon passage, this shall take effect on June 1, 2016.
- SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.



A Bill to Return Overtime Pay to American Workers

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
- 2 **SECTION 1**. The 2004 Amendments to the Fair Labor Standards Act covering the
- definition of exempt employee and overtime pay is repealed.
- 4 **SECTION 2**. Only those employees and positions considered exempt prior to 2004
- shall continue to be exempt from overtime regulations.
- 6 **SECTION 3.** The Department of Labor shall be responsible for enforcement of this
- 7 legislation.
- 8 **SECTION 4.** This shall take effect six months after passage.
- 9 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.



A Resolution to Amend the Constitution to Allow for Sensible Gun Ownership

1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:		
2	RESOLVED,	By two-thirds of the Congress here assembled, that the following article	
3		is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the United States,	
4		which shall be valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Constitution	
5		when ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several states	
6		within seven years from the date of its submission by the Congress:	
7			
8	SECTION 1:	The second amendment to the constitution shall be amended to read "As	
9		a strong military is necessary to the security of a free state, the right of	
10		the people to keep and bear arms when actively engaged in the security	
11		of the state shall not be abridged."	
12	SECTION 2:	The Congress shall have power to enforce this article by appropriate	
13		legislation.

A Resolution to Keep Iran From the Syrian Table

1	WHEREAS, Iran has only recently agreed to a nuclear accord; and
2	WHEREAS, the leadership of Iran has not yet demonstrated that they are trustworthy;
3	and
4	WHEREAS, multi-party talks on the Syrian civil war are extremely delicate; and
5	WHEREAS, Russian insistence on Iranian participation is designed to deflect attention
6	from Russian interference in Syrian affairs; and
7	WHEREAS, if these talks are not handled in a sensitive manner, it could further
8	destabilize the region; now, therefore, be it
9	RESOLVED, By the Congress here assembled that the United States refuse to participate
.0	in multi-party talks if Iran is allowed to participate in the negotiations.



A Bill to prevent Medical Professionals From Discriminating

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT: Any medical practitioner who receives reimbursement payments from SECTION 1. 2 Medicare or Medicaid is prohibited from denying treatment on the basis 3 of sexual orientation or gender identification. **SECTION 2.** In addition to denying treatment to the patient himself/herself, violations 5 of this law shall also include such practices as refusing to treat patients 6 on the basis of sexual orientation of other family members and refusing 7 referrals to other medical personnel. 8 SECTION 3. The Department of Health and Human Services shall oversee 9 enforcement of this legislation. A medical practicioner found in violation 10 of this legislation shall be ineligible for further reimbursement payments 11 from Medicare or Medicaid for a period of not less than five years. 12

All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

This will take effect upon passage.

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A Bill to Protect Privacy on **Electronic Networks**

2	SECTION 1.	Posting personal information on an electronic network without the
3		permission of the individual shall be a Class E Felony.
4	SECTION 2.	Electronic networks may include social media, internet web pages, or
5		other methods using wired or wireless networks. Personal information
6		may include name, address, birthdate, pictures, or any other informatio
7		not otherwise publically disclosed.
8	SECTION 3.	The Department of Justice will coordinate with the Federal Bureau of
۵		Investigation to enforce this legislation. If it is found that data

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A Resolution to

- 1 WHEREAS, the Clean Power Plan will seek to limit carbon emissions; and
- 2 WHEREAS, this limit is a key element to United Nations energy policy; and
- 3 WHEREAS, these limits on carbon emissions will have a detrimental effect on American
- 4 oil companies; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the economic recovery is currently stagnating; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the harm to oil companies will lead to an economic downturn; and
- 7 WHEREAS, alternative energy programs have been shown to be inefficient; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the United States should not concern itself with the environmental concerns
- of other countries; now, therefore, be it
- 10 **RESOLVED,** By the Congress here assembled that the Clean Power Plan shall not take effect.
