# A Bill to Call for the Release of Executive Tax Returns

- **SECTION 1**. All candidates for President and Vice President will be required to submit 10 years of tax returns for public record.
- **SECTION 2**. Tax Returns are defined as federal income tax documents that have been officially filed with the Internal Revenue Service.
- **SECTION 3.** Failure to follow through with the releasing of each candidate's tax returns will result in the candidate being barred from running for their respective position.
- SECTION 3. The Internal Revenue Service will oversee the enforcement of the bill.
- **SECTION 4.** This bill will be implemented upon passage.
- **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# A Resolution to Restore Democracy in Iraq and Syria

- WHEREAS, Individuals in Iraq and Syria have been negatively affected by Genocide and War Crimes;
- WHEREAS, Terrorism is still rampant within urban and rural communities; and
- **WHEREAS**, Government entities and members are still perpetuating corruption; now, therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED,** That the Congress here assembled make the following recommendations to the State Department of the United States to identify individuals that have ties to ISIS, genocide, and war crimes in the current government structures; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That targeted economic sanctions be placed on those individuals.

# A Bill to Bar Members of Congress from Serving on Corporate Boards

- SECTION 1. Members of Congress shall no longer be allowed to serve on the Board of Directors of any for-profit or corporate entity.
- **SECTION 2**. For-profit entities are defined as corporations whose primary goal is making profit or surplus.
- **SECTION 3.** All members of congress have to divest from their positions on boards within 3 months of passage, or they will be removed from office.
- SECTION 3. The Office of Congressional Ethics will oversee the enforcement of the bill.
- **SECTION 4.** This bill will be implemented upon passage.
- **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

### A Bill to Fund Marine Debris Clean Up

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- SECTION 1. The United States will spend 50 million dollars on marine debris clean up efforts.
- **SECTION 2**. Marine debris is defined as human-created waste that has deliberately or accidentally been released into an open water source, such as lakes, seas, and oceans.
- **SECTION 3. A.** 25 million dollars will go toward research and development of alternative bio-based materials that reduce human-created solid waste.

**B.** 25 million dollars will go toward marine debris clean up initiatives.

- **SECTION 3.** The Environmental Protection Agency and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration will oversee the enforcement of the bill.
- **SECTION 4.** This bill will be implemented at the start of FY 2020.
- SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

### A Bill to Elevate the United States Cyber Command

- **SECTION 1**. The United States will distinguish the United States Cyber Command as a 6th Branch of the Armed Forces.
- **SECTION 2**. The United States Cyber Command is currently a unified command under the Department of Defense and specializes in broad cyberspace operations.
- SECTION 3. A. 12 billion dollars will be Cyber Command's fiscal year 2020 budget.
  - **B.** All funding will be taken from the existent Armed Forces budget.
- SECTION 3. The Department of Defense will oversee the enforcement of the bill.
- **SECTION 4.** This bill will be implemented at the start of FY 2020.
- **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

### **A Bill to Increase Firearm Regulations**

- **SECTION 1**. All firearm transfers between private parties, i.e unlicensed individuals, will be prohibited unless a background check is completed.
- **SECTION 2**. Firearm transfers between private parties include sales on the internet and in person between two or more unlicensed individuals.
- **SECTION 3.** All firearm transfers between private parties are prohibited unless a licensed gun dealer or manufacturer acts as a mediator and conducts a background check on the beneficiary.
- **SECTION 3.** The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms will oversee the enforcement of this legislation.
- **SECTION 4.** This bill will be implemented immediately upon passage.
- SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

### **A Bill to Welcome High-Skilled Immigrants**

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- **SECTION 1**. **A.** The per-country yearly cap for family-based immigration visas is increased from 7% to 15%.
  - **B.** The 7% cap for employment-based immigration visas is removed.
- **SECTION 2**. **A.** Family-based immigration visas are visa sponsorships for individuals that have familial relationships with a United States Citizen.

**B.** Employment-based immigration visas include visa sponsorships for professionals holding advanced degrees (EB-2), worker sponsorships (EB-3), certain special immigrants (EB-4), and immigrant investors (EB-5).

- SECTION 3. A. 15% of EB-2, EB-3, and EB-5 visas will be reserved for individuals not from the two countries with the largest number of recipients of such visas.B. No more than 85% of the unreserved visas can be alloted to immigrants from any single country.
- **SECTION 3.** The U.S Immigration and Customs Enforcement will oversee the enforcement of this legislation.
- **SECTION 4.** This bill will be implemented immediately upon passage.
- SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

### A Bill to Sanction Venezuela

- **SECTION 1**. The United States Government will cease all and any trade relations with the country of Venezuela.
- **SECTION 2**. Trade relations shall be defined as the exchange of capital, goods, and services across international borders or territories.
- **SECTION 3.** Trade between the United States and Venezuela includes, but is not limited to, machinery, organic chemicals, agriculture products, auto parts, refined petroleum products, and the import and export of petroleum.
- **SECTION 3.** The Department of Commerce will oversee the enforcement of this legislation.
- **SECTION 4.** This bill will be implemented immediately upon passage.
- **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# A Bill to Increase the Quota of H1B Visas

- **SECTION 1**. The United States Government will double its current cap of 85,000 H1-B Visas per year to 170,000 H1-B Visas per year.
- **SECTION 2**. A H1-B Visa is defined as a temporary visa that employers use to hire immigrants for jobs that require a high level of knowledge and speciality.
- **SECTION 3.** A. Workers must have at least obtained a bachelor's degree.
  - **B.** A H1-B Visa enables the employed to legally work in the United States for a period of three years, with possibility of extensions.
- **SECTION 3.** The U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services will oversee the enforcement of this legislation.
- **SECTION 4.** This bill will be implemented immediately upon passage.
- SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

### **A Bill to Bolster Disaster Prevention Efforts**

- **SECTION 1**. The National Flood Insurance Program will be renewed for another period of 5 years.
- **SECTION 2**. The National Flood Insurance Program allows for property owners in disaster prone areas to purchase government administered flood insurance.
- **SECTION 3.** 10 million dollars will be allocated to the flood map revision process to revise which areas are more prone to disasters.
- **SECTION 3.** The Federal Emergency Management Agency will oversee the enforcement of the bill.
- **SECTION 4.** This bill will be implemented upon passage.
- **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
