When are Speech & Debate Tournaments?

- Most tournaments are on Saturdays. There will be a few that require us to travel on Fridays but those will be excused absences. There are typically 2 tournaments each month from September to March.
- Students must compete at 6 tournaments during the regular season.
- Students may pick and choose which tournaments to attend so that they can work around their personal schedules, as long as they meet the 6-tournament requirement.

Is The Speech & Debate Team a Class?

- Yes, students are enrolled in "Debate 1, 2, 3, or 4".
- Students earn elective credit.
