From the Executive Director

These past eight years that I have served as your NFL Executive Director have been enjoyable and rewarding. During this time I have become friends with such fine people. I have enjoyed working with you and your students these past eight years. I look forward to this year knowing that as we work together we will experience another great year.

This past school year NFL had one of its most successful years. We enrolled 22,366 new members, which exceeds our previous all time one year enrollment. We added 141 new chapters, 130 new affiliates and 3 new districts. We now have a grand total of 620,725 NFL members.

The 1985 individual events workshop was a tremendous success. I was so pleased with the dedication of the staff and the desire of 99% of the students to excell. The 1986 workshop will be held in June and July. We will restrict the number of students allowed to enroll again this year.

We just completed one of the largest and most successful NFL tournaments in our history. It was the first tournament to guarantee every student 6 rounds of main event competition, also the first tournament to have a super ses-

Executive Council Meeting Saturday, June 15, 1985 Eau Claire, Wisconsin

Present: James Copeland, Frank Sferra, Phyllis Barton, Carmendale Fernandes, Donus Roberts, Bro. Rene Sterner, FSC, Ronald Last, H. B. Mitchell and Dennis Winfield.

Moved, seconded and carried unanimously that an order form for the Forensic Quarterly be sent to each NFL school. Each school will return the order form for the number of copies they wish. The first copy will be furnished free, but additional copies will be sold at whatever cost there is to NFL.

Moved, seconded and carried unanimously that the Council instruct the Executive Director to make clear the progression and regression for becoming a small or large district or losing district status altogether. This progression and regression is as follows:

A small district will consist of at least 10 chapter schools and will be allowed to send one entry in each of the events and two students in debate and student congress to the national tournament, if all other NFL requirements are met.

If the small district drops below 10 chapter schools, it shall be on probation for one year and if it is unable to have 10 chapter schools the year after being on probation the district shall be dissolved.

A large district shall consist of 20 chapter schools and will be allowed to send two entries in each of the events and four students in debate and student congress to the national tournament, if all other NFL requirements are met. If the district should drop below 15 chapter schools, it shall be placed on probation for one year. If the district is unable to build back up to the 20 chapter schools, it shall be dissolved if it is in a state with multi districts, and the chapter schools shall be reassigned to the other existing districts within the state. If it is in a state with only one NFL district, then it shall become a small district and be allowed to send only one entry in each of the events and two students in debate and student congress to the national tournament.

The possibility of the Lincoln-Douglas debate topic being the same for districts and nationals was discussed. It was unanimously decided to continue to do the same as we have done in the past.

A discussion was held on having speaker awards in debate. This matter will be deferred until more information is available on how this tournament ran with the guaranteed six rounds. Mrs. Barton was appointed to bring to the fall meeting a report on the possibilities of having speaker awards in debate at the national tournament.

District committee ballots will be mailed two weeks earlier than is currently done, so chapters will have more time to get their ballots back by the May 1st deadline.

The request of the Western Washington District to split their district

was denied, with the understanding they would be notified to build up their strength to 20 strong chapters for each of the proposed districts and refile their request later.

Moved, seconded and passed unanimously that Dennis Winfield be reappointed National Director for another two year term.

Moved, seconded and passed unanimously that Bro. Rene Sterner, FSC be appointed one of the administrator representatives on the Council and that H. B. Mitchell be appointed one of the administrator representatives on the Council for two year terms.

Mr. Sferra and Mr. Roberts were appointed to bring to the fall agenda a report on plagerism, its extent and possible solutions.

Moved, seconded and passed unanimously that Dennis Winfield and James Copeland look into the possibility of an NFL press that would distribute teaching materials for profit. Their report will be given at the fall meeting.

It was decided to defer until the December meeting the matter of the top 6 entries from any school being the ones that count for the individual tournament sweepstakes.

It was moved, seconded and adopted that a report be given at the fall meeting concerning how NFL will determine the national sweepstakes winner at the national tournament. Any coaches wishing to submit a letter or suggested ideas to the Council on this matter of determining the sweepstakes winner should send their letter or report to Mr. Winfield by October 1st.

Bro. Rene Sterner, Donus Roberts and James Copeland were appointed to review the system of awarding points for the Bruno E. Jacob Trophy and to bring to the fall meeting a recommendation of how the Bruno E. Jacob points should be awarded at the national tournament.

Moved, seconded and passed unanimously that this Council go on record as expressing gratitude, not only from the Council but also from the coaches and students, for the past 10 years of service given by Mr. Ronald Last as a member of the Executive Council.

Moved, seconded and carried unanimously that NFL buy the national trophies for the national tournament in the future.

Moved, seconded and passed unanimously to discuss in detail the requirements of judging obligations and judging fees for our national tournament. It was put to the fall agenda so we would have data from this year's national tournament.

Moved, seconded and passed unanimously that a report from the NFL Conference on the State of Debate be presented at the fall meeting and the Council members reaction to any recommendation of the Conference.

Moved, seconded and carried unanimously that the following be submitted to the chapters for a vote:

Constitutional Amendment:

That Article VII, Section B, Paragraph 2 read as follows:

Resolved that direct election be substituted for preferential ballot in the national council election. That the council as a whole will elect a President and Vice President biannually from the generally elected members.

It was felt that a direct election would simplify the election process. Many coaches have indicated they do not understand the present system. A direct election would eliminate some of the confusion, it would also make possible the counting of the ballots by computer.

Meeting adjourned.

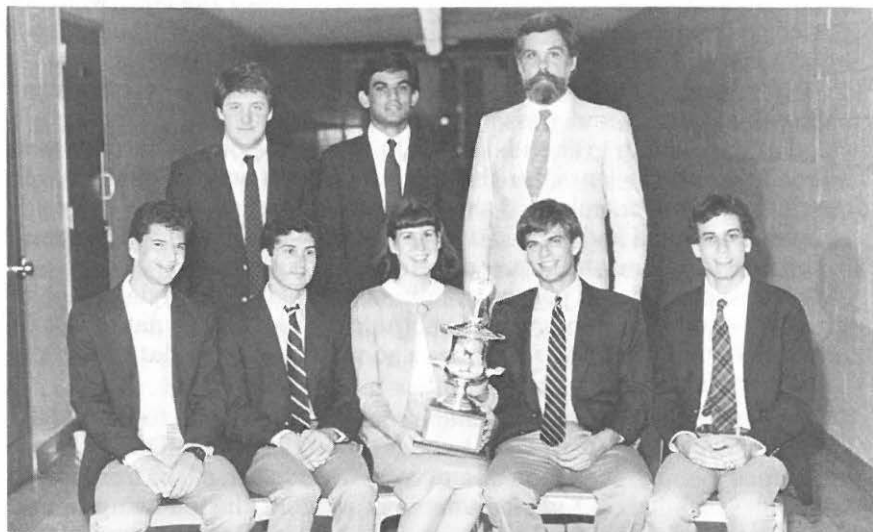
1985 Tournament Winners

At the 1985 National tournament and Student Congress 610 schools were represented by 1321 students. The fifty-fifth NFL National Tournament was held on the campus of the University of Wisconsin at Eau Claire, Wisconsin. All final rounds were held at Eau Claire Memorial High School. Our National Hosts were Mr. Art McMillion and his wife Mrs. Ruth McMillion. Mr. Ken Thames and Dr. Robert Sampson were the University of Wisconsin at Eau Claire Coordinators.

National Trophy

The National Trophy named in the memory of Mr. Bruno E. Jacob, founder of the National Forensic League, was presented to Bellaire High School, Houston, Texas.

The award is presented to the school which has the largest number of accumulated rounds of National participation. The scoring is based upon one point for each round of individual event participation and two points for each round of cross-examination

These young people were coached by Mr. David Johnson. Bellaire High School has earned the National Trophy two previous times.
